## **ORDINANCE**

## APPROVING A RISK MITIGATION POLICY FOR THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO TO MINIMIZE RESIDENTIAL DISPLACEMENT.

**WHEREAS**, in August 2018 the City Council of the City of San Antonio accepted the Mayor's Housing Policy's Task Force's Housing Policy Framework which set forth several policy recommendations to combat the City's affordable housing challenges; and

**WHEREAS**, one of the Task Force's recommendations was for the City to establish a policy to mitigate displacement of vulnerable populations; and

**WHEREAS**, staff recommends that the City adopt the Risk Mitigation Policy as recommended by the Task Force; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS:

**SECTION 1.** The Risk Mitigation Policy is adopted as recommended by the Mayor's Housing Policy Task Force. A copy of the policy is attached and incorporated by reference **ATTACHMENT I.** 

**SECTION 2.** No funds will be expended by this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon its passage by eight affirmative votes of the City Council. If less than eight affirmative votes are received, then this Ordinance is effective ten days after passage.
