AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF AN ADDITIONAL \$101,750.00 FROM THE OFFICE OF NATIONAL DRUG CONTROL POLICY FOR THE HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREA GRANT TO INCREASE THE ORIGINAL FUND AWARD FOR THE GRANT PERIOD JANUARY 1, 2018, THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2019.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2017-10-12-0793, the City of San Antonio accepted a High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Initiative grant from the Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) in the amount of \$1,988,146.00; and

WHEREAS, the ONDCP has offered additional grant funds, and now offers additional grant funds in an amount up to \$67,000.00 for the San Antonio HIDTA Task Force and \$34,750.00 for the South Texas HIDTA Intelligence Center; and

WHEREAS, no matching contribution is required; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the San Antonio Chief of Police or designee, is hereby authorized to accept additional grant funds from the ONDCP for the 2018 HIDTA grant for the period beginning January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2019, in an amount not to exceed \$67,000.00 for the San Antonio HIDTA Task and in an amount not to exceed \$34,750.00 for the South Texas HIDTA Intelligence Center, for a total amount of \$101,750.00, which will increase the total grant award to \$2,173,681.00. The City Manager and designee are further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said acceptance.

SECTION 2. Upon acceptance, \$67,000.00 from ONDCP will be appropriated into Internal Order 117000000241 and \$34,750.00 will be appropriated into Internal Order 117000000240, both in Fund 2202817006. The proposed amended budget, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit A**, is approved.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP

Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage, provided that it is passed by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, this ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
