ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$484,918.00 TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH TRANSYSTEMS CORPORATION, INC. FOR ADDITIONAL CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION SERVICES FOR THE CONSOLIDATED RENTAL CAR FACILITY PROJECT AT SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

WHEREAS, in February 2013 the City and TranSystems Corporation, Inc. ("TranSystems") entered into the Architectural Design Services Agreement for the Consolidated Rental Car Facility (CONRAC) at San Antonio International Airport; and

WHEREAS, the construction time for the CONRAC project increased and it is necessary to increase TranSystem's scope of work to add extended construction administration services; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend TranSystem's agreement to add additional services and increase the contract amount in the not to exceed amount of \$484,918.00; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, is authorized to execute the amendment to the Professional Services Agreement with TranSystems Corporation, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$484,918.00, a copy of which is set out in **Exhibit 1**.

SECTION 2. Payment in the amount not to exceed \$484,918.00 in SAP Fund 51099000, Airport Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 33-00079, Consolidated Rental Car Facility, is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to TranSystems Corporation, for additional construction administration services for the ConRAC.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
