HIDTA Mission

 To reduce drug trafficking in the San Antonio metropolitan area by instituting innovative narcotic enforcement investigations and seizing illegally obtained assets in an effort to reduce the profitability of narcotics trafficking.

Program Results

- 2018 Program Results
 - 121 Arrests
 - 168 Firearms Seized
 - \$5.3 Million Seized
 - \$4.9 Million Seized Drugs
- 19 members of the SAPD participate in the HIDTA Unit
 - 3 Sergeants
 - 8 Detectives
 - 8 Civilian Analysts
