ACCEPTING THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BID AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT, INCLUDING ONE (1) ADDITIVE ALTERNATE, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$783,000.00 AUTHORIZED PAYABLE TO AMSTAR, INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE DISTRICT FIVE PARKS IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS (NORMOYLE, COLLINS GARDEN AND PALM HEIGHTS), 2012-2017 GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND FUNDED PROJECTS, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 5.

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2012, San Antonio voters approved the 2012 - 2017 Bond Program, consisting of five propositions totaling \$596 Million; and

WHEREAS, as part of the program, funds in the amount totaling \$1,500,000.00 in the Parks, Recreation and Open Space Improvements proposition were approved for Normoyle, Collins Garden and Palm Heights Parks; and

WHEREAS, all three projects, located in District 5, will provide for general park improvements, including park rehabilitation and development of new park infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, these projects were advertised as the District Five Park Improvements package for construction bids in the San Antonio Hart Beat, on the City's website and the Texas Electronic State Business Daily in September 2013; and

WHEREAS, plans also were available for review by potential bidders at the office of Bender Wells Clark Design located at 830 N. Alamo Street, San Antonio, Texas 78215; and

WHEREAS, bids for this project were opened on October 22, 2013 and nine (9) bidders responded; and

WHEREAS, of these, Amstar, Inc. submitted the lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, this contract will be awarded in compliance with the Small Business Economic Development Advocacy (SBEDA) Program, which requires contracts be reviewed by a Goal Setting Committee to establish a requirement and/or incentive unique to the particular contract in an effort to maximize the amount of small, minority, and women-owned business participation on the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Goal Setting Committee set a 20% Small Business Enterprise (SBE) subcontracting goal and a 15% Minority/Women Business Enterprise (M/WBE) subcontracting goal; and

WHEREAS, Amstar, Inc. has committed to achieving 20% SBE and 15% M/WBE subcontractor participation; and

WHEREAS, in addition, Amstar, Inc. is also a certified small business; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive qualified bid in the amount of \$783,000.00 from Amstar, Inc., including two (2) additive alternates for construction of the District Five Parks Improvement Projects (Normoyle, Collins Garden and Palm Heights) is hereby accepted. The contract described herein shall become effective upon the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates so long as such deposits are accomplished within sixty (60) days from the effective date of this ordinance. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the contract becoming effective or the expiration of sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first. A copy of the contractor's executed Formal Invitation for Bids and Contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I.**

SECTION 2. Payment in the amount of \$381,785.00 in SAP Fund 45099000, General Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 40-00343, Collins Garden Park, is authorized to be encumbered with a purchase order and made payable to Amstar, Inc., for a construction contract. Payment is limited to the amounts budgeted in the Operating and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with Operating and/or Capital Budgets for current and future fiscal years.

SECTION 3. Payment in the amount of \$91,600.00 in SAP Fund 45099000, General Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 40-00378, Normoyle Park, is authorized to be encumbered with a purchase order and made payable to Amstar, Inc., for a construction contract.

SECTION 4. Payment in the amount of \$309,615.00 in SAP Fund 45099000, General Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 40-00383, Palm Heights Park, is authorized to be encumbered with a purchase order and made payable to Amstar, Inc., for a construction contract. Payment is limited to the amounts budgeted in the Operating and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with Operating and/or Capital Budgets for current and future fiscal years.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.

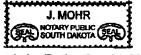
