RECOMMENDING TO APPROVE LIMITED PURPOSE ANNEXATION OF AREA #1; AREA #2; AREA #3, SAVE AND EXCPET PARCELS OUTSIDE THE CURRENT CITY SOUTH MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY BOUNDARY,; AND, DENIAL OF LIMITED PURPOSE ANNEXATION OF AREA #4, UNDER THE PROVISION OF CHAPTER 43 OF THE TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 43 of the Texas Local Government Code provides that a City may conduct annexation for limited purposes; and

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of San Antonio at it's meeting in December of 2012, directed the Department of Planning & Community Development to implement "Option 2" of the Effectiveness Study & Economic Strategic Plan for the City South Management Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission and Zoning Commission was briefed on the limited purpose annexation proposal and the subsequent dissolution of the City South Management Authority, as a component of "Option 2", at a joint commission briefing on November 1, 2013; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of San Antonio will conduct the requisite first and second public hearings regarding the proposed limited purpose annexation on December 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> of the year 2013; **NOW** 

## THEREFORE:

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** The Planning Commission of the City of San Antonio recommends to **approve** the limited purpose annexation of Area #1; Area #2; Area #3, save and except parcels outside the boundaries of the current City South Management Authority boundary; and, **denial** of limited purpose annexation of Area #4. The City of San Antonio may annex the subject areas before the third anniversary of the date of the limited purpose annexation.

**SECTION 2.** The subject areas are included in the Planning Study and Regulatory Plan document attached as Exhibit A for purposes of considering the limited purpose annexation of all or portions of the areas in accordance with applicable law.
