AN ORDINANCE

ACCEPTING THE BIDS FROM GRANDE TRUCK CENTER, DOGGETT FREIGHTLINER OF SOUTH TEXAS, LLC AND SANTEX TRUCK CENTER, LTD TO PROVIDE 19 REPLACEMENT MEDIUM AND HEAVY DUTY TRUCKS TO THE CITY'S SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT, TRANSPORTATION & CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS, AVIATION, AND PARKS & RECREATION DEPARTMENTS FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$2,090,386.24, FUNDED FROM THE EQUIPMENT RENEWAL AND REPLACEMENT FUND AND AIRPORT OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE FUND.

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WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio Solid Waste Management, Transportation and Capital Improvements, Aviation, and Parks and Recreation Departments with 19 replacement medium and heavy duty trucks to support the transport of earth and materials for various operations across the City; and

WHEREAS, the low bids submitted by Silsbee Ford for items 2, 3, and 9 and the low bid submitted by Santex Truck Center, LTD for item 7 failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements; and

WHEREAS, Grande Truck Center was the lowest responsive bidder for items 2, 3, 7 and 9 for a total cost of \$743,118.00; and

WHEREAS, Doggett Freightliner of South Texas, LLC was the lowest responsive bidder for items 5, 8, and 10 for a total cost of \$1,246,996.00; and

WHEREAS, Santex Truck Center, LTD was the lowest responsive bidder for item 6 for a cost of \$100,272.24; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive bids described above submitted by Grande Truck Center, Doggett Freightliner of South Texas, LLC and Santex Truck Center, LTD to provide the City of San Antonio Solid Waste Management, Transportation and Capital Improvements, Aviation, and Parks and Recreation Departments with medium and heavy duty trucks for a total cost of \$2,090,386.24 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. The bid tabulation sheets are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**. Copies of the bids are available for inspection in the offices of the Purchasing Division of the Finance Department.

SECTION 2. It has been found and declared that the low bids from Silsbee Ford for items 2, 3, and 9 and the low bid submitted by Santex Truck Center, LTD for item 7 failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements.

SECTION 3. Funding in the amount of \$2,016,079.24 for this ordinance is available in Fund 72001000, Cost Center 350320001 and General Ledger 5501055 as part of the Fiscal Year 2016 Budget.

SECTION 4. Funding in the amount of \$74,307.00 for this ordinance is available in Fund 51001000, Cost Center 3305040008 and General Ledger 5501050 as part of the Fiscal Year 2016 Budget.

SECTION 5. Payment not to exceed \$743,118.00 is authorized to Grande Truck Center and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 6. Payment not to exceed \$1,246,996.00 is authorized to Doggett Freightliner of South Texas, LLC and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 7. Payment not to exceed \$100,272.24 is authorized to Santex Truck Center, LTD and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 8. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 9. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
