**AN ORDINANCE**

**AUTHORIZING THE AMENDMENT AND MONTH TO MONTH  
EXTENSION OF A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH  
GONZABA MEDICAL GROUP FOR THE ADMINISTRATION AND  
MANAGEMENT OF THE CITY'S EMPLOYEE HEALTH AND WELLNESS  
CENTER FOR A PERIOD OF NO LONGER THAN TWELVE MONTHS,  
AND AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$250,000.00, WHICH IS THE  
AMOUNT BUDGETED FOR THE CENTER FUNDED IN THE EMPLOYEE  
BENEFITS FUND**

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Antonio and Gonzaba Medical Group entered into an agreement pursuant to Ordinance No. 2008-05-01-0354, under which Gonzaba Medical Group provides administration and management of the City's Occupational Health and Wellness Center which includes drug testing, pre-employment physicals, job related vaccinations, care for employee illness and injury, and ancillary onsite services; and

**WHEREAS**, the cost for the Contract Amendment is an estimated amount of \$250,000.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties now wish to amend the contract to provide for a month-to-month extension to begin September 1, 2014, on an as-needed basis, and expire no later than August 31, 2015, as set forth in the attached agreement; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City's Occupational Health and Wellness Center Contract with Gonzaba Medical Group is hereby amended to extend the contract on a month-to-month basis, from September 1, 2014 through no later than August 31, 2015, as set forth in Attachment 1. The terms of the Amendment and Extension are hereby approved. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to execute said Amendment and Extension.

**SECTION 2.** Funding for this Ordinance is contingent upon budget appropriation in the Employee Benefits Fund 75002000, Cost Center 1002050001 Wellness, General Ledger 5201040, Fees For Professional Contractors.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
