ACCEPTING THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BID AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT, INCLUDING TWO (2) ADDITIVE ALTERNATES, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$427,833.00 AUTHORIZED PAYABLE TO THE GFP GROUP, FOR CONSTRUCTION OF DISTRICT ONE PARK IMPROVEMENTS PROJECTS (DELLVIEW, KENWOOD AND LOS ANGELES HEIGHTS), 2012-2017 GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND FUNDED PROJECTS, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 1.

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2012, San Antonio voters approved the 2012 - 2017 Bond Program, consisting of five propositions totaling \$596 Million; and

WHEREAS, the Bond Program funds will be used on various capital improvement projects, to address community infrastructure needs and improve the overall quality of life in San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, as part of that program, funds in the total amount of \$700,000.00 in the Parks, Recreation and Open Space Improvements Bond funds were approved for park improvements for Dellview, Kenwood and Los Angeles Heights Parks all located within Council District 1; and

WHEREAS, these projects were advertised as the District One Park Improvements package for construction bids in the San Antonio Hart Beat, on the City's website and the Texas Electronic State Business Daily in September 2013; and

WHEREAS, plans also were made available to potential bidders at the office of the Terra Design Group located at 816 Camaron, San Antonio, Texas 78212; and

WHEREAS, bids for this project were opened on October 15, 2013 and eight bidders responded; and

WHEREAS, of these, the GFP Group submitted the lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, this contract will be awarded in compliance with the Small Business Economic Development Advocacy (SBEDA) Program, which requires contracts be reviewed by a Goal Setting Committee to establish a requirement and/or incentive unique to the particular contract in an effort to maximize the amount of small, minority, and women-owned business participation on the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Goal Setting Committee set a 22% Small Business Enterprise (SBE) subcontracting goal and a 17% Minority/Women Business Enterprise (M/WBE) subcontracting goal; and

WHEREAS, the GFP Group has committed to achieving 22% SBE and 17% M/WBE subcontractor participation; and

WHEREAS, in addition, the GFP Group is also a certified small business; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive qualified bid in the amount of \$427,833.00 from the GFP Group, including two (2) additive alternates for construction of the District One Park Improvements Projects is hereby accepted. The contract described herein shall become effective upon the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates so long as such deposits are accomplished within sixty (60) days from the effective date of this ordinance. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the contract becoming effective or the expiration of sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first. A copy of the contractor's executed Formal Invitation for Bids and Contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I.

SECTION 2. Payment in the amount of \$156,776.00 in SAP Fund 45099000, General Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 40-00347, Dellview Park, is authorized to be encumbered with a purchase order and made payable to the GFP Group for a construction contract.

SECTION 3. Payment in the amount of \$93,254.00 in SAP Fund 45099000, General Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 40-00364, Kenwood Park, is authorized to be encumbered with a purchase order and made payable to the GFP Group for a construction contract. Payment is limited to the amounts budgeted in the Operating and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with Operating and/or Capital Budgets for current and future fiscal years.

SECTION 4. Payment in the amount of \$177,803.00 in SAP Fund 45099000, General Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 40-00371, Los Angeles Heights Park, is authorized to be encumbered with a purchase order and made payable to the GFP Group for a construction contract. Payment is limited to the amounts budgeted in the Operating and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with Operating and/or Capital Budgets for current and future fiscal years.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.

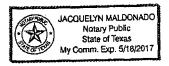
