## AN ORDINANCE

ACCEPTING THE LOWEST QUALIFIED BID AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO J. SANCHEZ CONTRACTING, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$433,445.00 IN CONNECTION WITH THE LEON CREEK GREENWAY - CATHEDRAL ROCK PARK SITE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, A 2005 PROPOSITION 2 SALES TAX INITIATIVE FUNDED PROJECT LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 6.

WHEREAS, the proposed construction project is part of a growing network of interconnected hike and bike trails now known as the Howard W. Peak Greenway Trails system, which is funded through sales tax initiatives approved by voters in May of 2000, May of 2005 and November of 2010; and

WHEREAS, the objectives of the program are to acquire and preserve open space along San Antonio creekways and to develop multi-use hike and bike trails, trailheads, signage and associated amenities for use by San Antonio residents and visitors; and

**WHEREAS**, this ordinance will authorize the construction of a hike and bike trail system along the Leon Creek Greenway - Cathedral Rock Park Site; and

WHEREAS, these improvements will become unique additions to the municipal park system's creekways program for hiking, biking, and other recreational uses; and

WHEREAS, the Request for Low Qualified Bids was advertised the third and fourth week of March 2014 in the Hart Beat, the Texas Electronic State Business Daily, the City's website, and announced on the City's public access station TVSA, five bids were received; and

**WHEREAS,** after reviewing the bidders' qualifications and conducting interviews, J. Sanchez Contracting, Inc. was selected with the lowest qualified bid of \$433,445.00; and

**WHEREAS,** the Goal Setting Committee set a 17% Minority/Women Business Enterprise (M/WBE) subcontracting goal and a 1% African American Business Enterprise (AABE) subcontracting goal; **NOW THEREFORE:** 

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** The lowest responsive qualified bid in the amount of \$433,445.00 from J. Sanchez Contracting, Inc. is hereby accepted. The contract described herein shall become effective upon the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates so long as such deposits are accomplished within sixty (60) days from the effective date of this ordinance. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the contract becoming effective or the expiration of sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first. A copy of the contractor's executed Formal Invitation for Bids and Contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I.** 

**SECTION 2.** Payment in the amount of \$433,445.00 in SAP Fund 40005000, Park Improvements SAP Project Definition 26-00077, Leon Creek Greenway (Bandera Rd To Military), is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to J. Sanchez Contracting, Inc., for construction services.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
