ORDINANCE

NAMING A BRIDGE ON JONES MALTSBERGER ROAD, BETWEEN OAKLINE DRIVE AND OLD TRAIL DRIVE, THE “SFC DAVID JAMES TODD, JR. MEMORIAL BRIDGE”, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICTS 9 AND 10.

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WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio received a request originating from City Council District 10 to name a bridge located on Jones Maltsberger Road, between Oakline Drive and Old Trail Drive, in honor of SFC David James Todd, Jr., who was killed in the line of duty in 2008 while serving in the United States Army, and received the Purple Heart Medal and Bronze Star Medal from the United States Army; and

WHEREAS, staff began implementing this request through the naming process as required by Chapter 6 of the City Code; and

WHEREAS, a committee was formed consisting of City staff and representatives from both Council Districts 9 and 10 to review the naming request, and a public meeting was held on April 25, 2018, where support in favor of the naming was unanimous; and

WHEREAS, staff properly posted and mailed notice of this bridge naming request to abutting property owners, and notice requirements for naming of the bridge have been satisfied in accordance with Chapter 6 of the City Code: **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The bridge located on Jones Maltsberger Road, between Oakline Drive and Old Trail Drive, is hereby named “SFC David James Todd, Jr. Memorial Bridge”, located in Council Districts 9 and 10. All naming requirements of Chapter 6 of the City Code have been met. The location of the bridge naming is more specifically depicted in Attachment I. City staff is directed to provide appropriate signage to this effect.

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$250.00 for this ordinance is available in Fund 11001000 and Cost Center 2312020001 and General Ledger 5301030 as part of the Fiscal Year 2018 Budget.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

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SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective 10 days after passage.
