Brief Description of Item(s) and Use:

This contract will provide a variety of veterinary vaccines, pharmaceuticals and supplies to benefit the animals served by Animal Care Services Department (ACS). As a municipally-owned animal shelter, ACS operates under an open-admission system, caring for approximately 25,000 animals per year. These veterinary vaccines, pharmaceuticals and supplies will ensure ACS animals receive an appropriate level of veterinary care and that proper supplies are available to the ACS employees who work and care for these animals.
