

## A RESOLUTION

### ACKNOWLEDGING THE RESIGNATION OF COUNCILWOMAN ELISA CHAN, DISTRICT 9; AND INITIATING PROCEDURES TO SELECT A REPLACEMENT COUNCILMEMBER.

**WHEREAS**, Councilwoman Elisa Chan, District 9 representative on the City Council, has resigned from her place on the Council, stating the effective date to be October 18, 2013; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the City of San Antonio City Charter, Section 8, a vacancy on the Council may be filled by a majority vote of the remaining members until an election may be held to fill the office for the remainder of the unexpired term; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 2010-05-06-0375 established procedures for the appointment of temporary replacement Council members in the event of a vacancy; **NOW THEREFORE:**

#### **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council acknowledges the resignation of Councilwoman Elisa Chan, District 9.

**SECTION 2.** The City Council directs the Office of the City Clerk to immediately post notice on the City website and publish advertisements in the local newspaper, inviting qualified residents of the district to submit applications, letters of interest, resumes, and disclosure statements to the City Clerk.

**SECTION 3.** The deadline to submit applications, letters of interest, resumes, and disclosure statements to the City Clerk is 5:00 p.m., Friday, November 1, 2013.

**SECTION 4.** The City Council will interview qualified candidates of interest at the City Council's "B" Session on Wednesday, November 6, 2013.

**SECTION 5.** The City Council will vote on the candidates for District 9 at the City Council's "A" Session on Thursday, November 7, 2013. The successful candidate will be sworn in and take office at that meeting.

**SECTION 6.** In accordance with the City Charter requirements, a Special Election shall be called at a later date, to be held on the next uniform election date, May 10, 2014, to elect the replacement Council member.

**SECTION 7.** This Resolution is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
