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This Certificate of Exemption is executed and filed with the Finance Department as follows:

1. The undersigned is authorized to approve an exemption.
2. An exemption according to Section 252.022 of the Local Government Code exists. More specifically, the following event has occurred:

The Solid Waste Management Department is required by State Statute to collect refuse from every customer every week for the health and safety of the community. Operational demands of the Solid Waste Management Department requires very specific design characteristics. The City of San Antonio is seeking to purchase 11 trucks with Freightliner M2 106 chassis 4 trucks will be equipped with Loadmaster Excel-S bodies and 7 trucks will be equipped with New Way King Cobra bodies, these rear load trucks will be used for refuse collection throughout the City. While this is available on a cooperative, the local dealer (Doggett Freightliner of South Texas) that offers this make should be given an opportunity to bid as part of Request for offers.

3. Because the exemption stated above exists, the City of San Antonio intends to contract with Doggett Freightliner of South Texas which will cost approximately \$ 1,855,007.00.
