## AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH CANTU CONTRACTING, INC. TO PROVIDE MOWING SERVICES FOR THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR AN ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$2,122,000.00 ANNUALLY, FUNDED WITH THE GENERAL FUND AND PARKS ENVIRONMENTAL FUND.

**WHEREAS**, the City released Request for Competitive Sealed Proposals (RFCSP) to provide the City with mowing services for the Parks and Recreation Department; and

WHEREAS, six responses were received and four were evaluated, as two of the respondents failed to include the required bid bond; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends Cantu Contracting, Inc. for award of this contract; NOW THEREFORE:

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** The proposal submitted by Cantu Contracting, Inc. to provide the City with mowing services for the Parks and Recreation Department is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. A copy of the score summary, RFCSP, and price schedule are attached hereto as **Exhibit I**. A copy of the proposal may be inspected in the offices of the Purchasing Division of the Finance Department.

**SECTION 2.** It has been found and declared that the proposals from LaMed Facility Maintenance Inc. and Estrada Landscape failed to meet the City's requirements by failing to submit the required bid bond.

**SECTION 3.** Funds will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders, and payment is authorized to Cantu Contracting, Inc. All current fiscal year expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2015 budget approved by City Council, and future fiscal year expenditures are contingent upon future City Council budget approvals. The estimated annual cost of this contract is \$2,122,000.00.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage hereof.
