

AN ORDINANCE 2015-11-12-0945

AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF ONE POSITION TO THE EXISTING PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT FOR THE FY 2016 TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF STATE HEALTH SERVICES SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED DISEASE/HIV GRANT INCREASING THE NUMBER OF POSITIONS FROM 9 TO 10.

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WHEREAS, as the public health agency for the City of San Antonio, Bexar County and the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (Metro Health) actively addresses the public health functions of policy development, health assessment and health assurance and promotion; and

WHEREAS, with state and federal grant support, Metro Health provides preventive health services, community health education, emergency preparedness, supplemental nutrition programs, dental health services and limited clinical services to prevent and control the transmission of communicable disease; and

WHEREAS, the Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD) / Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) grant (Grant) supports STD/HIV prevention efforts and funding objectives include: testing for STDs and HIV, conducting field investigations for confirmed or suspected cases of Syphilis and HIV positive clients, case management of all confirmed Syphilis and HIV positive clients and identification and interview of partners for notification and testing; and

WHEREAS, in October 2015, Metro Health was awarded an additional \$125,000.00 to fund an additional position that would focus on a new "Data to Care" role for the Grant; and

WHEREAS, this position will be responsible for re-establishing linkages with healthcare for HIV positive individuals who have fallen out of care; and

WHEREAS, this action will authorize an increase of one position for the Grant program for the remainder of FY 2016 for a total of ten positions; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (Metro Health) or his designee is authorized to add one position to the existing personnel complement for the FY 2016 Texas Department of State Health Services Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD) / Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) grant increasing the number of positions from 9 to 10. The revised proposed personnel complement of one additional position for FY 2016 attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I** is approved.


SECTION 2. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP


SECTION 3. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
