1. **Question:** The pricing form lists 10' chain link as a bid item and specifications lists three different types of chain link: standard, security, and tennis course safeguard. Need clarification on which to bid on.

Response: The 025 Unit Pricing Form will be amended to include pricing for both the 10' high tennis court fencing and 10' high standard chain link fencing.

2. **Question:** The pricing form lists cedar fence as a bid item; however, need clarification on which specification to bid on.

Response: The cedar privacy fence is the specification to bid on. Please refer to drawing #: B-5 of Specifications.
