


This Certificate of Exemption is executed and filed with the Finance Department as follows:

1. The undersigned is authorized to approve an exemption.
2. An exemption according to Section 252.022 of the Local Government Code exists. More specifically, the following event has occurred:

The San Antonio Police Department Helicopter Unit will receive a new Airbus H125 unit in July 2019 with only CNC Technologies hardware pre-installed. This aircraft unit will still require the CNC Technologies down-link software along with the installation of the CNC Technologies receive site at our Fusion Center located at the San Antonio Police Department Headquarters. Currently we have no live link interoperability with Bexar County and Department of Public Safety who both use the CNC Technologies down-link software system. By purchasing this specific application, we make use of the equipment pre-installed in the new aircraft and have interoperability with Bexar County and Department of Public Safety on events that require a multi agency response such as a terroristic act or natural disaster. The entire mission suite, which includes hardware installation on three Airbus H120 units already in the Police Department's fleet, installation at the receive site (SAPD HQ), subscription costs and recurring costs per aircraft per year for a 5 year contract will be \$1,796,086.

3. Because the exemption stated above exists, the City of San Antonio intends to contract with CNC Technologies which will cost approximately \$ 1,796,086.
