Tickets to literacy enables students/schools from each district to access subsidized tickets for main stage literacy based live theatrical performances at The Magik Theatre. Student tickets are \$5 and many Title 1 schools cannot afford that amount. Tickets to literacy enables Magik to offer these schools ticketing from \$4 to free depending on the school's financial capability and number of students attending. Some schools cannot attend main stage productions, many times because of transportation costs, so for those schools Magik offers touring productions. Tour productions have a similar pricing structure to main-stage, with a minimum guarantee of \$400. Magik accesses funds from Tickets to Literacy to help subsidize these touring shows for schools that cannot afford the full touring price. Magik maintains a list of schools by District that utilize the subsidize ticketing and supply this to all Council offices annually.

The Magik Theatre is entering its 23rd season, with a mission to nurture young people's love and understanding of theatre and literature by providing extraordinary, affordable, professional theatre and education experiences. Since our inception, we have **employed** more than **270 theatre professionals** more than **200** main-stage and touring **shows**, played to more than **2 million people** from over **750 schools in 85 school districts**, and **employed** more than **270 theatre professionals**.

The Magik Theatre has spent more than twenty years bringing books and their characters to life for our young audiences. As a leader in San Antonio's arts community – and the only resident, professional theatre company – Magik feels a strong responsibility to ensure that the arts remain an integral part of San Antonio students' education. Our ticket subsidy program discounted **58,066 student** tickets in the past year for low income schools, **5,759** of which were free to the schools; and another **9,125** students saw one of our touring shows free.

Magik works with some of San Antonio's most at-risk youth in three juvenile detention centers through our successful X-celerated Theatre program. Our Academy and summer Camp Showbiz programs provide world-class theatre arts education, at reasonable costs, with scholarships available for low-income families. Our teacher workshops, outreach, Magik on the Road touring program, internship program, and the annual Shakespeare in the Park are just a small part of the impact your business can make by supporting The Magik Theatre.
