In addition, per the contract, please submit the current certificate of insurance information and continuation certificate for the performance bond prior to commencement of the renewal term.

As provided in the enabling Ordinance, the contract renewal does not become final until City Council approves staff's recommendation and authorizes the renewal of the contract. It is anticipated that City Council will consider this action on June 4, 2015.
