# Background

- Multi-agency cost sharing effort since 2015 to enhance efficiencies for emergency response
- Agencies include:
  - Metro Health
  - Southwest Texas Regional Advisory Council (STRAC)
  - DSHS Region 8
  - All hospital facilities throughout DSHS Region 8





# Background



- The EverBridge Mass Notification System is used to notify medical staff in an emergency event
- Coordination of a full scale exercise to meet HPP/PHEP grant requirements
- Central MEDCOM Communications Center to rapidly dispatch AmBuses, helicopters, and disaster response team assets 24/7
- Coordination with other preparedness/EOC Representatives from the community for sharing of best practices





# Fiscal Impact



- Funding for an agreement with STRAC is available and budgeted within Metro Health's FY 2018-19 Public Health Emergency Preparedness grant. Amount not to exceed \$7,500
- Term: July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2019
- There is no impact to the General Fund



# Recommendation



Staff recommends approval of an agreement with the Southwest Texas Regional Advisory Council for EverBridge License and maintenance services related to public health emergency preparedness
