A RESOLUTION

ACKNOWLEDGING THE RESIGNATION OF COUNCILMEMBER CARLTON SOULES, DISTRICT 10; AND INITIATING PROCEDURES TO SELECT A REPLACEMENT COUNCILMEMBER.

WHEREAS, on Monday, December 9, 2013, Councilmember Carlton Soules, District 10 representative on the City Council, resigned from his place on the Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City of San Antonio City Charter, Section 8, a vacancy on the Council may be filled by a majority vote of the remaining members until an election may be held to fill the office for the remainder of the unexpired term; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2010-05-06-0375 established procedures for the appointment of temporary replacement Council members in the event of a vacancy; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council acknowledges the resignation of Councilmember Carlton Soules, District 10.

SECTION 2. The City Council directs the Office of the City Clerk to immediately post notice on the City website and publish, as soon as possible, advertisements in the local newspaper, inviting qualified residents of the district to submit applications, letters of interest, resumes, and disclosure statements to the City Clerk.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk is authorized to begin accepting applications, letters of interest, resumes and disclosure statements on Thursday, January 2, 2014.

SECTION 4. The deadline to submit applications, letters of interest, resumes, and disclosure statements to the City Clerk is 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, January 15, 2014.

SECTION 5. The City Council will interview qualified candidates of interest at the Council's "B" Session on Wednesday, January 29, 2014.

SECTION 6. The City Council will vote on the candidates for District 10 at the Council's "A" Session on Thursday, January 30, 2014. The successful candidate will be sworn in and take office at that meeting.

SECTION 7. In accordance with the City Charter requirements, a Special Election shall be called at a later date, to be held on the next uniform election date, May 10, 2014, to elect the replacement Council member.
