

Background

- The State Fire Marshal's report had 11 findings and recommendations concerning the Line of Duty Death of firefighter Scott Deem.
- Out of the 11 recommendations 9 can be addressed through the implementation of the <u>Hazard Zone Incident Commander Certification</u> <u>Program.</u>







Goals of the Program

- Establish and implement formalized command training and certification program to:
 - Develop Fire Department Officers who serve in the role of Incident Commander.
 - Evaluate and then certify personnel who successfully finish curriculum.
- Standardize incident operations for the San Antonio Fire Department.
- Eliminate costly mistakes that cause injury, death, and unnecessary fire losses.



Funding

 The ordinance authorized a contract to provide Incident
Command training and certification for every Fire
Officer and in the San Antonio
Fire Department.

• The ordinance provided funding for FY 2019 through the General Fund Budget with additional funding for future fiscal years subject to the appropriation of funds.

Blue Card Status

- 12 train trainers will begin the training class in April.
- Blue Card training will begin for all Fire Officers in June and will run every other week.
- Training will take 3 years to complete.
