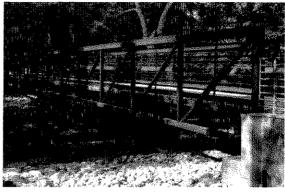

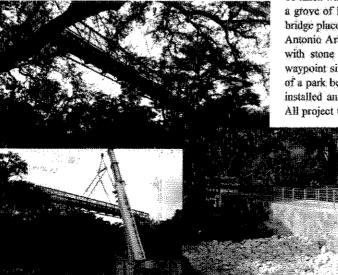
With the Construction of the New Wurzbach Parkway, the previously constructed Salado Central Greenway need to be reconnected to McAllister Park which is the trailhead for the greenway.

J. Sanchez Contracting constructed the trail on time and with in budget with just a few minor changes that need to be made because Wurzbach Parkway had fallen behind sched-

The projected included the construction of a 10' wide by 1.03 mile long concrete linear trail that was constructed to comply with TDLR specifications. Construction included a steel prefabricated 120' long pedestrian bridge. This bridge was placed with a crane and had to be coordinated with the nearby San Antonio International Airport. Great care had to be taken when placing the bridge as it was being snaked into a grove of large heritage oaks. All prior prep-work for the bridge placement had to be coordinated with the City of San Antonio Arborist. Work also included a drainage structure with stone veneered retaining walls & box culvert, park waypoint signage, site grading, hydromulch and installation of a park bench. This project required tree protection to be installed and inspected throughout the construction period. All project tree printing was completed by a licensed arbor-

> ist and coordinated with the cities arborist. Further coordination was done for the NOI permit with the Texas Commission On Envirnmental Quality (TCEQ).

Obstacles on this project included the pedestrians using the trails surrounding this project and in excavation as this project was designed over a landfill.

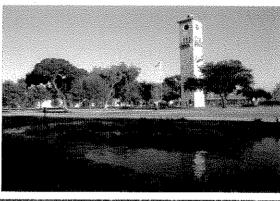

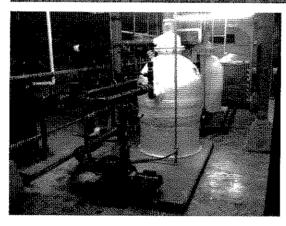

Demo Existing Duck Reflecting Pool & Install New Duck Pond Fort Sam Houston, San Antonio TX







With increased public & Government Officer visitation to the Quadrangle, US Army North upgraded their existing wildlife wade pool.

J. Sanchez Contracting, Inc. demolished the existing reflecting pool and constructed a 65'x42' new, two level wild-life pool with creek feature and waterfall. The duck pond was constructed using boulders & stone permanently embedded in the "shotcrete" perimeter & floor. The filtration system, pumps, UV sanitizers and controls were installed in the basement under the Quadrangle. All utility from the pool to the filtration system was under ground and had to be coordinated with the facilities Management.

The Quadrangle remained operational and open to the public during construction. The building itself is still use by US Army North Command. One of the biggest obstacles was that the pond was located near the low lying branches of the "Quadrangle Oak". This huge oak was selected as the second most historic tree in the area in 1976 by the San Antonio Bicentennial Committee. Spotters were used while equipment was in motion near the large oak and for pedestrians and wildlife that roams freely about the facility.

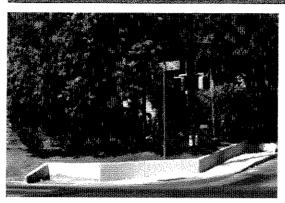

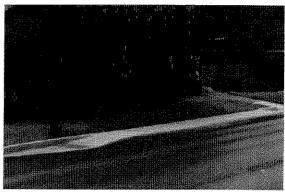

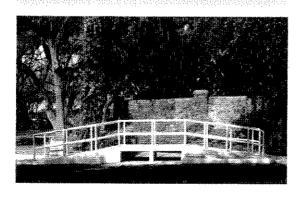

driveways, install sidewalk handicap ramps, minor HMAC paving, pavement markings, removal & relocation of irrigation systems, installation of push button pedestrian crossing signals, & installation of pedestrian bridge ramps. Sidewalks and ramps were constructed to meet with TDLR specifications. All major work took place during school summer months as to not create school zone congestion. Some construction took place at the beginning of the new school year. All precautions and safety signage was used and maintained during this time as their were school crossing zones in the construction limits. Coordination was done with digtess to locate utilities before any excavation took place. Further coordina-

tion was with the city inspector and the homeowners
