ZONING CASE # Z2017002 CD (Council District 1) – November 15, 2016

A request for a change in zoning from "C-2 NA AHOD" Commercial Nonalcoholic Sales Airport Hazard Overlay District to "C-1 CD AHOD" Light Commercial Airport Hazard Overlay District with Conditional Use for a Tattoo Parlor on Lot 26, Block 50, NCB 2744, located at 1620 Fredericksburg Road. Staff recommends Approval with Conditions.

Staff mailed 32 notices to the surrounding property owners, 2 returned in favor, 0 returned in opposition. Keystone Neighborhood Association is in favor, Montecello Park and Woodlawn Lake Neighborhood Associations are in opposition, and no response from Jefferson Heights.
