

AN ORDINANCE 2014 - 05 - 15 - 0327

ACCEPTING THE LOWEST QUALIFIED BID AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO J. SANCHEZ CONTRACTING, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$433,445.00 IN CONNECTION WITH THE LEON CREEK GREENWAY - CATHEDRAL ROCK PARK SITE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, A 2005 PROPOSITION 2 SALES TAX INITIATIVE FUNDED PROJECT LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 6.

WHEREAS, the proposed construction project is part of a growing network of interconnected hike and bike trails now known as the Howard W. Peak Greenway Trails system, which is funded through sales tax initiatives approved by voters in May of 2000, May of 2005 and November of 2010; and

WHEREAS, the objectives of the program are to acquire and preserve open space along San Antonio creekways and to develop multi-use hike and bike trails, trailheads, signage and associated amenities for use by San Antonio residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance will authorize the construction of a hike and bike trail system along the Leon Creek Greenway - Cathedral Rock Park Site; and

WHEREAS, these improvements will become unique additions to the municipal park system's creekways program for hiking, biking, and other recreational uses; and

WHEREAS, the Request for Low Qualified Bids was advertised the third and fourth week of March 2014 in the Hart Beat, the Texas Electronic State Business Daily, the City's website, and announced on the City's public access station TVSA, five bids were received; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing the bidders' qualifications and conducting interviews, J. Sanchez Contracting, Inc. was selected with the lowest qualified bid of \$433,445.00; and

WHEREAS, the Goal Setting Committee set a 17% Minority/Women Business Enterprise (M/WBE) subcontracting goal and a 1% African American Business Enterprise (AABE) subcontracting goal; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive qualified bid in the amount of \$433,445.00 from J. Sanchez Contracting, Inc. is hereby accepted. The contract described herein shall become effective upon the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates so long as such deposits are accomplished within sixty (60) days from the effective date of this ordinance. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the contract becoming effective or the expiration of sixty (60) days

from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first. A copy of the contractor's executed Formal Invitation for Bids and Contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**.

SECTION 2. Payment in the amount of \$433,445.00 in SAP Fund 40005000, Park Improvements SAP Project Definition 26-00077, Leon Creek Greenway (Bandera Road to Military), is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to J. Sanchez Contracting, Inc., for construction services.

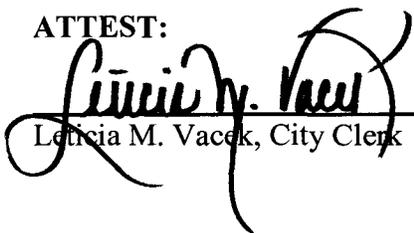
SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.

With the Construction of the New Wurzbach Parkway, the previously constructed Salado Central Greenway need to be reconnected to McAllister Park which is the trailhead for the greenway.

J. Sanchez Contracting constructed the trail on time and with in budget with just a few minor changes that need to be made because Wurzbach Parkway had fallen behind schedule.

The project included the construction of a 10' wide by 1.03 mile long concrete linear trail that was constructed to comply with TDLR specifications. Construction included a steel prefabricated 120' long pedestrian bridge. This bridge was placed with a crane and had to be coordinated with the nearby San Antonio International Airport. Great care had to be taken when placing the bridge as it was being snaked into a grove of large heritage oaks. All prior prep-work for the bridge placement had to be coordinated with the City of San Antonio Arborist. Work also included a drainage structure with stone veneered retaining walls & box culvert, park waypoint signage, site grading, hydromulch and installation of a park bench. This project required tree protection to be installed and inspected throughout the construction period. All project tree pruning was completed by a licensed arborist and coordinated with the cities arborist. Further coordination was done for the NOI permit with the Texas Commission On Environmental Quality (TCEQ).

Obstacles on this project included the pedestrians using the trails surrounding this project and in excavation as this project was designed over a landfill.

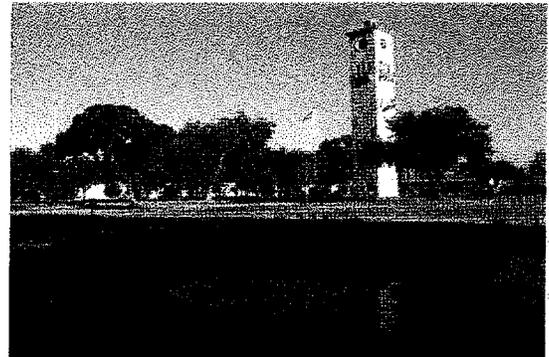
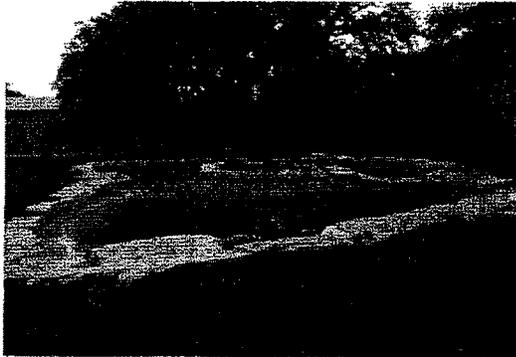

With increased public & Government Officer visitation to the Quadrangle, US Army North upgraded their existing wildlife wade pool.

J. Sanchez Contracting, Inc. demolished the existing reflecting pool and constructed a 65'x42' new, two level wild-life pool with creek feature and waterfall. The duck pond was constructed using boulders & stone permanently embedded in the "shotcrete" perimeter & floor. The filtration system, pumps, UV sanitizers and controls were installed in the basement under the Quadrangle. All utility from the pool to the filtration system was under ground and had to be coordinated with the facilities Management.

The Quadrangle remained operational and open to the public during construction. The building itself is still use by US Army North Command. One of the biggest obstacles was that the pond was located near the low lying branches of the "Quadrangle Oak". This huge oak was selected as the second most historic tree in the area in 1976 by the San Antonio Bicentennial Committee. Spotters were used while equipment was in motion near the large oak and for pedestrians and wildlife that roams freely about the facility.

The objective of this project was to install sidewalks & sidewalk handicap ramps along both sides of about 0.66 miles of North New Braunfels Ave.

Construction included the removal of existing sidewalks & driveways, installation of new sidewalks & driveways, install sidewalk handicap ramps, minor HMAC paving, pavement markings, removal & relocation of irrigation systems, installation of push button pedestrian crossing signals, & installation of pedestrian bridge ramps. 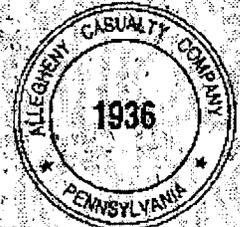

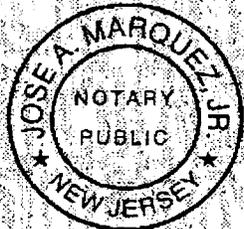
