**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**


**SECTION 1.** The City of San Antonio City Council declares every Friday before Mother's Day to be Military Spouse Appreciation Day.

**SECTION 2.** This Resolution is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.


