
**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**


**SECTION 1.** George Lynn Britton Jr. is reappointed to the Building Standards Board for the remainder of an unexpired term to expire May 31, 2021.


**SECTION 2.** The category requirement of "Veteran" is waived for this appointment.

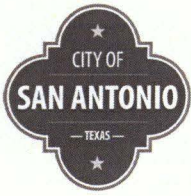
**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes, otherwise, it is effective ten days after appointment.
