AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING THE MAJOR THOROUGHFARE PLAN, A COMPONENT OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO MASTER PLAN, BY: (1) REALIGNING A PROPOSED SEGMENT OF THE NORTH/SOUTH CONNECTOR, A SECONDARY ARTERIAL TYPE A REQUIRING 86 FEET OF RIGHT-OF-WAY, BETWEEN POTRANCO ROAD AND MARBACH ROAD ON THE MAJOR THOROUGHFARE PLAN; AND (2) REALIGNING A PROPOSED SEGMENT OF MARBACH ROAD, A SECONDARY ARTERIAL TYPE A REQUIRING 86 FEET OF RIGHT-OF-WAY, ON THE MAJOR THOROUGHFARE PLAN BETWEEN GROSENBACHER ROAD AND HIGHWAY 211, GENERALLY LOCATED IN WEST BEXAR COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio Major Thoroughfare Plan was adopted on September 21, 1978 by City Council as a component of the City Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on December 4, 2013 by the Planning Commission allowing all interested citizens to be heard; **NOW THEREFORE**;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The Major Thoroughfare Plan, a component of the Master Plan of the City, is amended by (1) Realigning a proposed segment of the North/South Connector, a Secondary Arterial Type A requiring 86 feet of right-of-way, between Potranco Road and Marbach Road on the Major Thoroughfare Plan; and (2) Realigning a proposed segment of Marbach Road, a Secondary Arterial Type A requiring 86 feet of right-of-way, on the Major Thoroughfare Plan between Grosenbacher Road and Highway 211, generally located in west Bexar County. The Proposed Amendment to the Major Thoroughfare Plan as a component of the City of San Antonio Master Plan is more particularly described in **Attachment "I"**, attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.
