**ORDINANCE**

**APPROVING THE REALLOCATION OF \$250,000.00 FROM THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVE FUND TO THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TO CONDUCT A STUDY TO DETERMINE PRELIMINARY ALIGNMENT AND FEASIBILITY FOR AN EAST/WEST CONNECTOR BETWEEN PLEASANTON ROAD AND HIGHWAY 281 SOUTH.**

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**WHEREAS**, as part of the recruitment of the Navistar production facility to San Antonio, the City offered \$250,000.00 in Economic Development Incentive Funds (“EDIF”) to study the feasibility of an east-west arterial roadway that would directly benefit the facility and was already part of the City’s Major Thoroughfare Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the development of the Navistar production facility has begun and so the need for the study has increased; and

**WHEREAS**, to expedite the study, the Public Works Department has proposed using the On-Call Traffic Engineering Services Agreement with Pape-Dawson that was approved by City Ordinance No. 2018-10-111-0818; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council approves the reallocation of \$250,000.00 from the Economic Development Incentive Fund (“EDIF”) to the Public Works Department to be utilized under an existing on-call contract with Pape-Dawson Engineers, Inc. to conduct a study to determine preliminary alignment and feasibility for an east/west connector between Pleasanton Road and Highway 281 South associated with the construction of the Navistar production plant.

**SECTION 2.** Funding in the amount of \$250,000.00 for this Ordinance is available in Fund 29059000, Cost Center 1604010001 and General Ledger 5201040 as part of the Fiscal Year 2020 budget.

**SECTION 3.** Payment is authorized to Pape-Dawson Engineers, Inc. under an existing on-call agreement with the City administrated by the Public Works Department.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager’s designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.
