REQUEST:

The applicant is requesting a Finding of Historic Significance for the property at 1123 W French Place.

FINDINGS:

a) The proposed landmark designation is owner initiated. b) The structure is situated between Blanco Road and Fredericksburg Road in the Treasure Hill Plat, which would now be referred to as Beacon Hill. c) The structure has simple detailing of Folk Victorian style, but the overall form and grand scale (large rooms and 11' ceiling height) reflects characteristics of the Queen Anne style. d) The significant character defining details which remain intact include: smooth Doric columns, wood lap siding, decorative-profiled gutters, and steeply pitched gabled and hipped roof forms.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of a Finding of Historic Significance for the property at 1123 W French Place based on findings a through d.
