AN ORDINANCE

ACCEPTING THE BID FROM GRANDE TRUCK CENTER FOR THE PURCHASE OF FOUR HALF TON TRUCKS FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$76,916.00, FROM THE PUBLIC PROPERTY FINANCE CONTRACTUAL OBLIGATIONS, SERIES 2013 FUND.

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WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the San Antonio Fire Department with four half ton trucks; and

WHEREAS, the bid from Grande Truck Center, a city business, was within 3% of the lowest bid submitted by Silsbee Ford, a non-city business; therefore, award is recommended to Grande Truck Center in accordance with the Local Preference Program adopted by Ordinance No. 2013-12-05-0865, for a total cost of \$76,916.00; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The bid submitted by Grande Truck Center to provide the City of San Antonio with four half ton trucks for a total cost of \$76,916.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. Attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I** are the bid tabulation sheet and bid.

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$76,916.00 for this ordinance is available in Fund 29089012, Cost Center 2005070005 and General Ledger 5709090, as part of the Fiscal Year 2014 Budget.

SECTION 3. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to Grande Truck Center and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

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SECTION 5. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage hereof.
