AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS UP TO \$1,000,000.00 FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR A COMPREHENSIVE SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM GRANT; AND AUTHORIZING A CASH MATCHING CONTRIBUTION UP TO \$300,000.00 AND AN IN-KIND MATCHING CONTRIBUTION UP TO \$225,355.00.

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has grant funds of as much as \$1,000,000.00 available for the Comprehensive Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) to combat the incidence of driving-while-intoxicated, distracted-driving, and vulnerable-road-user violations; and

WHEREAS, the grant period is from October 1, 2014, through September 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, an in-kind matching contribution not to exceed \$225,355.00 and a cash matching contribution not to exceed \$300,000.00 are required; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to accept a grant in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.00 from the TxDOT for funding for the STEP. In connection therewith, an in-kind matching contribution not to exceed \$225,355.00 and a cash matching contribution not to exceed \$300,000.00 are hereby authorized. The City Manager and her designee are further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said acceptance.

SECTION 2. Fund 26059000 (TxDOT) is hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this grant. Should funding be awarded, the amounts listed in Section 1 of this Ordinance will be appropriated in said fund.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts, as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
