

ORDINANCE 2019-11-07-0913

**APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT OF A LAWSUIT STYLED IRMA REDING AND REX REDING V. CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, CAUSE NUMBER 2017-CI-22496, PENDING IN 407<sup>TH</sup> JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT, BEXAR COUNTY, TEXAS IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$125,000.00.**

**WHEREAS**, an auto accident occurred on August 28, 2016 near the intersection of Enrique Barrera Parkway and Arvil Avenue in San Antonio, Texas involving a City owned vehicle and a vehicle being operated by Irma Reding in which Rex Reding was a passenger; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of this accident, Irma Reding and Rex Reding are seeking to recover damages; and

**WHEREAS**, although the City of San Antonio has vigorously contested this matter, it is in the City's best interest to settle this matter to avoid the uncertainties and risks associated with further litigation; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties have reached a mutual agreement to settle the claims of Irma Reding for the amount of \$75,000.00, and Rex Reding for the amount of \$50,000.00, for the total settlement amount of \$125,000.00 payable from the Self-Insurance Liability Fund subject to City Council approval; **NOW THEREFORE:**


**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The amount of \$125,000.00 is authorized to be paid from Fund 75001000, Insurance Reserve Fund, General Ledger 5402530 General Liability Claims, Cost Center 7509020001 Risk Management-Liability, and is authorized to be made payable as follows: \$75,000.00 will be paid to plaintiff Irma Reding and her attorney of record, and \$50,000 will be paid to plaintiff Rex Reding and his attorney of record; and as settlement of Cause Number 2017-CI-22496 styled Irma Reding and Rex Reding v. City of San Antonio.

**SECTION 2.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


**SECTION 3.** This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.


