Requests Authorization:



Submission of a Child Care Services grant application in the amount of \$46,242,717.00, for the period of October 1, 2017 - September 30, 2018, to Workforce Solutions Alamo (WSA) for the purpose of managing the CCS program in the 13 County Alamo Workforce Development Area.



The grant requires an in-kind match of up to \$3,665,255.00 and \$40,000.00 in program income, provided by the City of San Antonio, if awarded.

Background

CCS Program provides subsidized child care for families meeting income and qualification requirements.

In FY16, 9,466 children ages 0-12 were served on a daily basis through 645 contract child care vendors. Over 4,000 children are on a waiting list as of March 13, 2017.

TWC administers the State's subsidized child care program through HHS, Child Care Development Block Grant. TWC determines allocation based on needs, and contracts with WSA.

Through a competitive RFP process, WSA awards contracts with local agencies to provide program services.

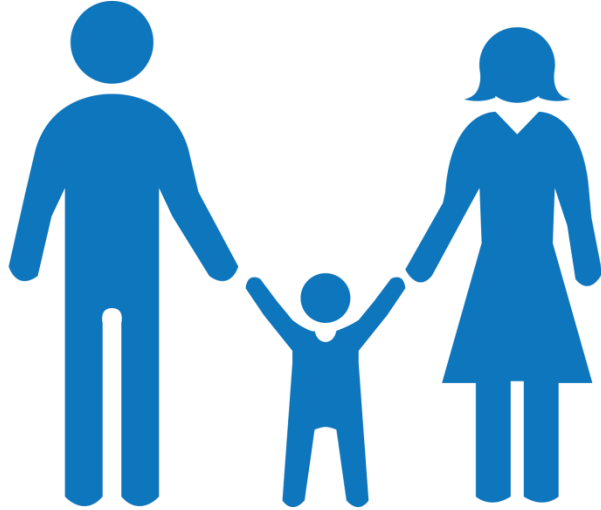
