Brief Description of Item(s) and Use: This contract will provide the Solid Waste Management Department (SWMD) with various sizes of roll-out carts for the collection of recyclables, organic materials, and refuse for the residents of San Antonio, including cart assembly, delivery, RFID Identification Tags and spare parts. This contract will allow for the purchasing of carts for the transition to the Variable Rate Pricing model for charging fees to residents for garbage service. This variable rate pricing program was initiated in October 2015. In addition, this contract will also allow for the purchase of replacement parts to repair carts that are no longer under warranty. These carts are provided to the residents that receive automated collection service. This contract will also allow the City to keep an inventory of carts in order to replenish those that are lost, damaged, or stolen.
