

AN ORDINANCE 2015-06-04-0487

AUTHORIZING PAYMENT FOR ELECTION SERVICES FOR THE JUNE 13, 2015 RUNOFF ELECTION WITH THE BEXAR COUNTY ELECTIONS ADMINISTRATOR IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$851,194.81.

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WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio has historically contracted with the Bexar County Elections Administrator to conduct its municipal elections jointly with other political subdivisions within the county and provide services relating to the elections; and

WHEREAS, the May 9, 2015 general election resulted in the necessity to hold a runoff election on Saturday, June 13, 2015, for the offices of the Mayor and City Council District 7; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2015-04-02-0236, passed and approved on April 2, 2015, in accordance with Section 31.092 of the Texas Election Code, authorized a contract with the Bexar County Elections Administrator to provide election services to the City in connection with the general and, if necessary, runoff elections, but payment for a runoff was not authorized at that time; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Funding for this ordinance is available as part of the Fiscal Year 2015 budget as set forth in the table below.

SECTION 2. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to the Bexar County Elections Administrator and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or her designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is effective immediately, if approved by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective on the tenth day from the date of passage.



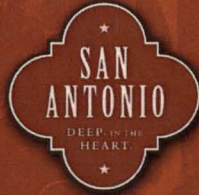

Contract for Election Services



- This Ordinance will approve the Contract for Election Services with Bexar County in an estimated amount not to exceed \$851,194.81 for the Run-off Election scheduled for June 13, 2015.
 - Services included in the Contract:
 - Procuring and distributing election supplies, to include the printing and distribution of mail ballots;
 - Hiring, training, and paying Election Judges, Clerks, and other Election Personnel;
 - Programming Election equipment to be utilized during Early Voting and Election Day; and
 - Tabulating Election Returns.

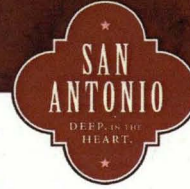

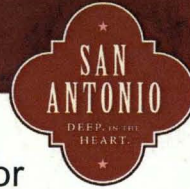
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Run-off Election – Early Voting

 - Monday, June 1 thru Friday June 5 from 8am to 6pm
 - Saturday, June 6 from 8am to 8pm
 - Sunday, June 7 – CLOSED
 - Monday, June 8 & Tuesday, June 9 from 8am to 8pm

Run-off Election – Election Day



- The Run-off Election is scheduled for Saturday, June 13, 2015 for Mayor and District 7.
 - A total of 237 Election Day Polling Sites will be utilized
 - Hours of Voting will be from 7am to 7pm
- Anyone who is registered or registered to vote by May 14, 2015 is eligible to vote in the Run-off Election.

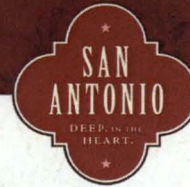
Coordination/Recommendation
