Brief Description of Item(s) and Use: This contract will provide the Building and Equipment Services Department with continuation of services with Automated Logic Contracting Services, Inc. for preventive maintenance and repairs for the Building Automation System (BAS). The BAS is a system that monitors and controls a building Heating Ventilation Air Conditioning (HVAC) system. The BAS will adjust building temperature and provides notification of component malfunctions such as overheating. The BAS is utilized at seven facilities; Animal Care Services, Emergency Operations Center, Municipal Plaza Building, Cliff Morton Development and Business Services Center (One Stop), Plaza De Armas, Public Safety Headquarters and Police Property and Evidence Storage Facility.

These items are being procured as a Sole source according to the provisions of the Texas Statutes Local Government Code 252.022.07. No other source can supply the items listed nor can any comparable item fulfill the same requirements.
