Brief Description of Item(s) and Use: This contract will provide the City of San Antonio Solid Waste Management Department (SWMD) with a contractor to procure various sizes of roll-out carts for the collection of recyclables, organics material, and refuse for the residents of San Antonio, including cart assembly, delivery, Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) Tags and Spare Parts. This contract will provide carts for the transition plan to the Variable Rate Pricing Program for charging residents for refuse service based upon variable factors. These carts are provided to the residents that receive automated collection service. Implementation of the new program will begin in FY2016. In addition, this contract will also provide replacement parts to repair carts that are out of warranty. These refuse containers are covered by a manufacturer's direct warranty of ten years to be free of defects on material and workmanship.
