


Purpose

- Purpose
 - support future economic development projects
 - Authorizing amendments to the TIRZ Project and Finance Plans
 - capture potential projects and areas of increasing property values
- Potential projects
 - 1. Essex Area proposed mixed use development
 - 2. Montana Street Proposed entertainment district
 - 3. Wyoming Street Proposed entertainment district
 - 4. Government Hill increasing values and the Region 20 Education facility
 - 5. MLK Park Area ChildSafe, Children's Advocacy Center and adjacent development


Subject Areas



Area #1 - Essex




Area #2 — Montana Street

Fiscal Impact Analysis

- Proposed amendment does not have a direct impact on the City's General Fund
- Beginning in tax year 2017, future tax increment will be deposited into Inner City TIRZ fund
- Future projects within subject areas could be eligible for future funding
- The proposed amendment does not obligate any funds

Staff Analysis and Recommendation

- Staff recommends Approval
 - Proposed amendment meets all statutory requirements
 - within the 30% residential requirement
 - Base value will be set to 2016 values
 - In 2017, increases in value above base will be deposited into TIRZ fund
 - New Inner City TIRZ boundary
 - 5,016 parcels
 - 2,821 parcel acres
