**AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO LONE STAR SITEWORK, LLC IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,116,513.22 FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE JUDSON ROAD SIDEWALKS (IH 35 TO INDEPENDENCE AVENUE) PROJECT, OF WHICH \$968,000.00 WILL BE FUNDED BY THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TXDOT) AND \$19,825.00 WILL BE REIMBURSED BY SAN ANTONIO WATER SYSTEM (SAWS).**

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**WHEREAS**, as part of the City's commitment to maintaining and improving existing infrastructure, the City will construct sidewalks on Judson Road from Independence Avenue to Interstate 35 leveraging funding from TxDOT; and

**WHEREAS**, this work will provide for sidewalks, curbs, accessibility ramps and the mill and overlay of pavement along the west side of Judson Road; and

**WHEREAS**, this project was selected for funding through the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (AAMPO) Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and

**WHEREAS**, the City will manage the project but receive federal funds administered through TxDOT; and

**WHEREAS**, City will pay TxDOT for TxDOT costs associated with oversight for administration of the federal funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the City advertised for construction bids in February 2020 and received and opened two bids on March 17, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid submitted by Lone Star Sitework, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$1,116,513.22; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The lowest responsive bid submitted by Lone Star Sitework, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$1,116,513.22 for construction of the Judson Road Sidewalks (IH 35 to Independence Avenue) project, is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates.

**SECTION 2.** Payment is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to Lone Star Sitework, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$1,116,513.22. Payment is in support of the Judson Road Sidewalk Project, Fund 40099000 and the Projects, WBS elements, and General Ledger

accounts in the table below. These funds are budgeted in the FY 2020 - FY 2025 Capital Improvement Program.

Payment is limited to the amounts budgeted in the Operating and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with approved operating and/or capital budgets for current and future fiscal years.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Fund Numbers, Project Definitions, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, Fund Centers, Cost Centers, Functional Areas, Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
