AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE FOLLOWING CONTRACTS ESTABLISHING UNIT PRICES FOR GOODS AND SERVICES FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST OF \$532,000.00: (A) MICHELSON FOUND ANIMALS FOUNDATION, INC. FOR REGISTERED MICROCHIPS FOR ANIMAL CARE SERVICES, (B) SUPPLY INNOVATIONS COMPANY, LLC, MASTERMAN'S LLP, AND SUNBELT MILL SUPPLY, INC. FOR ELECTROLYTE REPLACEMENT DRINKS, (C) TEXAS STAR SUPPLY, LLC FOR ASPHALT EMULSION SEALCOAT MATERIAL, AND (D) HAYS CITY CORPORATION DBA TEX-CON OIL COMPANY FOR BULK DIESEL EXHAUST FLUID.

WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio with commodities and services on an annual basis for the terms of the contracts; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance approves the following contracts: (A) Michelson Found Animals Foundation, Inc. for registered microchips for Animal Care Services, (B) Supply Innovations Company, LLC, Masterman's LLP, and Sunbelt Mill Supply, Inc. for electrolyte replacement drinks, (C) Texas Star Supply, LLC for asphalt emulsion sealcoat material, and (D) Hays City Corporation dba Tex-Con Oil Company for bulk diesel exhaust fluid; and

WHEREAS, the bids submitted by Supply Innovations Company, LLC (Items 5-7), Sunbelt Mill Supply, Inc. (Items 1-7), and Diamond Custom Blending, Inc. (Items 1-7) failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements for electrolyte replacement drinks; and

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by Tacot, Inc. failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements for asphalt emulsion sealcoat material; and

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by Cinco J. Inc. failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements for bulk diesel exhaust fluid; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance approves one low bid contract and five low qualifying bid contracts; and

WHEREAS, all expenditures will be in accordance with the applicable fiscal year's budget approved by City Council; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The following bids to furnish the City with goods and services on an annual basis as shown on the attached bid tabulation sheets are hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements: (A) Michelson Found Animals Foundation, Inc. for registered microchips for Animal Care Services, (B) Supply Innovations Company, LLC, Masterman's LLP, and Sunbelt Mill Supply, Inc. for electrolyte replacement drinks, (C) Texas Star Supply, LLC for asphalt emulsion sealcoat material, and (D) Hays City Corporation dba Tex-Con Oil Company for bulk diesel exhaust fluid. The bid tabulation sheets are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**. Copies of the bids are available for inspection in the offices of the Purchasing Division of the Finance Department.

SECTION 2. It has been found and declared that the bids submitted by Supply Innovations Company, LLC (Items 5-7), Sunbelt Mill Supply, Inc. (Items 1-7), and Diamond Custom Blending, Inc. (Items 1-7) for electrolyte replacement drinks failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements.

SECTION 3. It has been found and declared that the bid submitted by Tacot, Inc. for asphalt emulsion sealcoat material failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements.

SECTION 4. It has been found and declared that the bid submitted by by Cinco J. Inc. for bulk diesel exhaust fluid failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements.

SECTION 5. Funds will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders and payment is authorized to the vendors identified herein. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2017 budget and such other appropriations necessary to fund the contracts through their terms as evidenced by subsequent ordinances.

SECTION 6. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
