

ORDINANCE 2020-12-17-0940

AMENDING THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO MAJOR THOROUGHFARE PLAN, A COMPONENT OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO MASTER PLAN, BY REALIGNING A PROPOSED SEGMENT OF THE EAST & WEST CONNECTOR FROM FM 1516 TO LOOP 1604 AND A PROPOSED SEGMENT OF SCHUWIRTH ROAD FROM FM 1346 TO LOOP 1604, GENERALLY LOCATED IN EASTERN BEXAR COUNTY.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on November 18, 2020 by the Planning Commission allowing all interested citizens to be heard: **NOW THEREFORE;**


**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1:** The Major Thoroughfare Plan, a component of the Master Plan of the City, is amended to:

1. Realign a proposed segment of the East & West Connector from FM 1516 to Loop 1604 and a proposed segment of Schuwirth Road from FM 1346 to Loop 1604, generally located in eastern Bexar County.

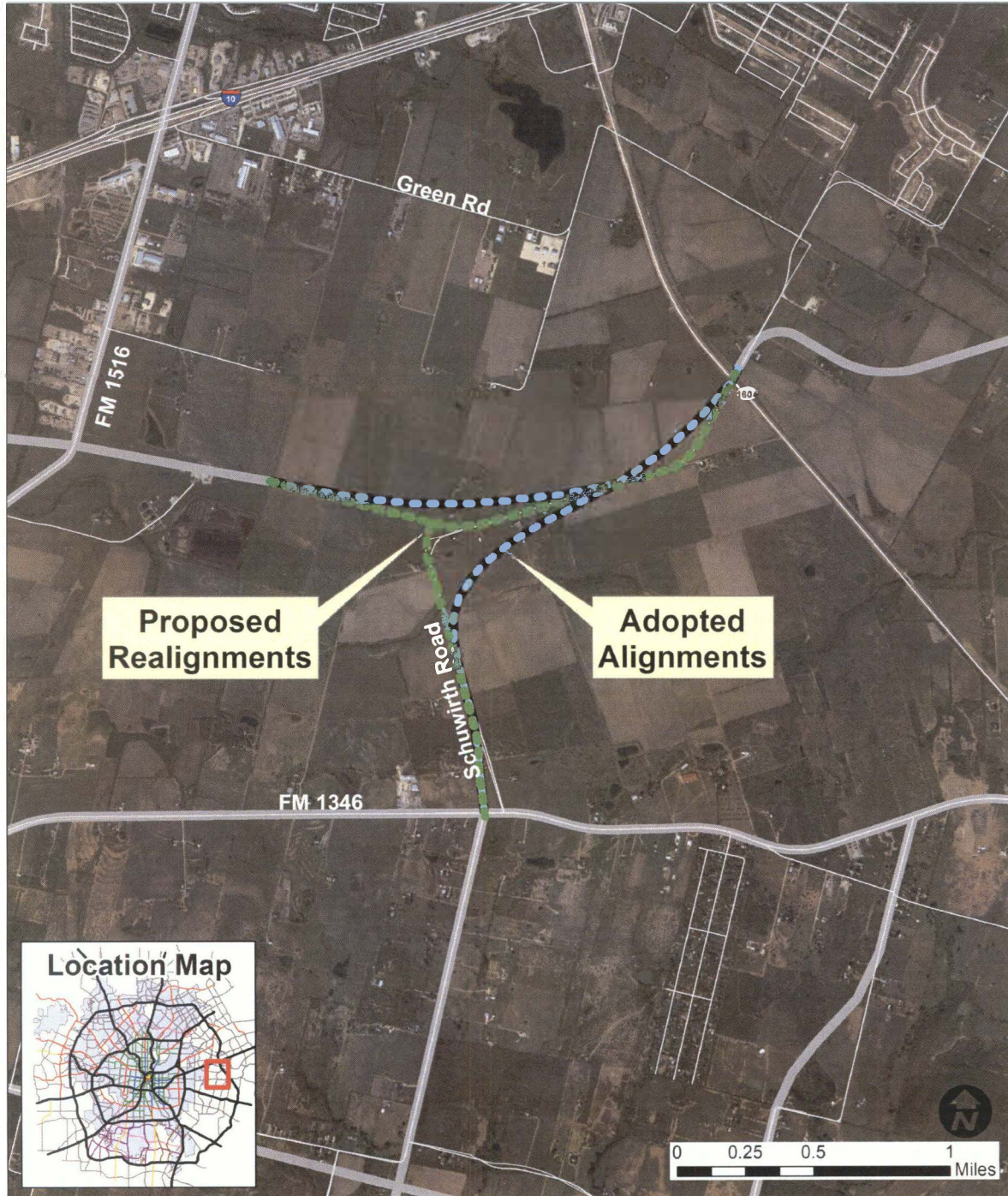

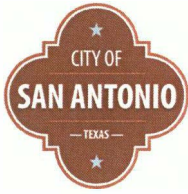
