

AN ORDINANCE      2014 - 10 - 30 - 0830

**DESIGNATING THE CHIEF OF POLICE AS THE  
AUTHORIZED OFFICIAL FOR THE POLICE CASE  
MANAGEMENT SYSTEM GRANT AWARDED BY THE  
OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, CRIMINAL JUSTICE  
DIVISION.**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 2014-09-04-0653 authorized the acceptance of grant funds from the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division (CJD), to support the San Antonio Police Department's Police Case Management System; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to amend Ordinance No. 2014-09-04-0653 to designate the Chief of Police as the authorized official; **NOW THEREFORE:**


**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** Section 2 of Ordinance No. 2014-05-15-0334 is hereby amended, in its entirety, as follows:

The City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of San Antonio to accept said grant. The City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the CJD funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the CJD in full. The City Council designates the Chief of Police as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**SECTION 2.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.


