The equipment was tested and evaluated over the period of several months to ensure ballistics performance met National Institute of Justice (NIJ) standards. The final selection was based upon functionality, durability, reliability and effective ballistic performance. This equipment will be utilized by the SAPD SWAT Unit, Bomb Squad, (Negotiators and K-9 Unit) and other Special Operation Units (SOU) consisting of Repeat Offenders, Narcotics and Street Crime Units.

Procurement Alternative:	Should this contract not be approved, the SAPD SWAT Unit and Bomb Squad may not be properly equipped to combat ballistic threats and other threat scenarios in the field. The alternative would be to purchase without the benefit of a contract wherein non-contract buying could delay the transition process of replacing the aged equipment in a timely manner and result in increased costs.
