

AN ORDINANCE

APPROVING A PARTNER DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT WITH THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE TO ALLOW THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A PUBLIC ACCESS PEDESTRIAN FOOT BRIDGE AS PART OF THE STINSON HIKE AND BIKE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, over the last four years, the Aviation Department has worked with the Parks and Recreation Department and United States National Park Service to develop a hike and bike project on 63 acres that the Aviation Department owns at Stinson Municipal Airport, which is located between Mission Road and the San Antonio River; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to connect the Stinson Hike and Bike Trail to the Mission Reach Project and provide access to the UNESCO World Heritage Missions; and

WHEREAS, this requires the construction of a pedestrian footbridge over the Acequia de Espada on land owned by the National Park Service (NPS); and

WHEREAS, the federal government requires an agreement between NPS and the City to outline the responsibilities of each party for the work related to the design, installation, construction, and transfer of ownership of the bridge; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute the Partner Design and Construction Agreement with the National Park Service to allow the design and construction of a public access pedestrian foot bridge as part of the Stinson Hike and Bike project, a copy of which is set out in **Exhibit 1**.

SECTION 2. Funding and payment authorization was previously approved and per originating department's RFCA details, there is no fiscal impact associated with this item; therefore, no fiscal ordinance language is required.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
