Milestones

- **1917** – Kelly Field founded in southwest Bexar Co.
- **1943** – Mission shifts from training to aircraft maintenance—rise as major SA employer for 50+ years.
- **1995** – Closure of Kelly announced by BRAC.
- **1997** – Greater Kelly Development Authority created; governed by 11-member board appointed by City Council.
- **1998** – Initial leases between redevelopment authority and aerospace companies that retain Kelly employees.
- **2001** – Kelly AFB formally closes.
- **2001** – Alamo Academies launched.
- **2007-10** – Port provides secure facility for military commands, including the 24th Air Force / Cyber Command headquarters.


Milestones

- **2008** – Organization rebrands as Port San Antonio.
- **2013-14** – CoSA + Port jointly develop aerospace growth strategy plan, emphasizing capability growth.
- **2010-Present** – Multiple cyber firms establish, grow operations at Port to support DoD and private sector.
- **2016** – Project Tech vision announced; 5,000 jobs by 2020.
- **2017-18** – Boeing, StandardAero announce new defense and commercial projects.
- **2017-18** – Port launches educational/innovation partnerships with SA Museum of Science and Technology.
- **2018** – First phase of Project Tech completed.
- **Today** – 3,000 aerospace, 1,000+ cyber jobs at Port
