

AN ORDINANCE 2015-04-30-0345

AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF A 12-ACRE PARCEL LOCATED AT THE CORNER OF RICHLAND HILLS AND INGRAM RD. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,815,000.00 PAYABLE TO SAWS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF MULTIPURPOSE ATHLETIC FIELDS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,500,000.00 AND AUTHORIZING THREE ANNUAL PAYMENTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$438,333.34 EACH IN MARCH 2016, 2017, AND 2018, CONTINGENT UPON APPROVAL OF BUDGETS IN SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEARS.

WHEREAS, in 2011, City Council District 6 provided funds for a study of the need for a new Recreation Center in the northwest quadrant of San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, in May of 2012, voters approved the 2012-2017 General Obligation Bond Program, of which \$3 million was designated for a project titled the Northwest Area Recreation Center in Council District 6 ; and

WHEREAS, the second phase of the project will be accomplished through a Public-Private Partnership (P3) to include the construction of multi-purpose athletic fields on a 12 acre parcel currently owned by SAWS; and

WHEREAS, a Development Agreement is being proposed in order to provide for the construction of the multipurpose athletic fields which could not be constructed at this time without this partnership. The Development Agreement is contingent upon the City's acquisition of the 12-acre property from SAWS; and

WHEREAS, this council action includes authorization for the City Manager to acquire the 12 acre parcel, at the corner of Richland Hills and Ingram Rd., from SAWS for use in this project;

WHEREAS, the athletic fields will be constructed on 6 of the 12 acres and the remaining 6 acres will be used for development of a market rate Senior Independent Living Facility containing 176 units valued at approximately \$19 million; and

WHEREAS, the property is currently owned by SAWS and is needed in order to move forward with the second phase of the project; and

WHEREAS, the City is proposing the acquisition of the 12-acre parcel from SAWS in the amount of \$2,815,000.00 of which the City will provide \$1,500,000.00 from 2015 Certificates of Obligation for the property and then provide \$438,333.34 over the next three years to until the remaining balance is paid off; and

WHEREAS. the City will acquire the 12-acre parcel in the amount of \$2,815,000.00 payable to SAWS, of which \$1,499,139.46 will be paid from various Certificates of Obligation and \$860.54 from 2012 General Obligation Bonds and the remaining balance will be paid in three installments of \$438,333.34 in FY 2016, \$438,333.34 in FY 2017 and \$438,333.34 in FY 2018 from the following sources:

1. Sale of land from the Southwest Technology & Business Park
2. Sale of City property to SAWS
3. Project savings
4. Proceeds from P3 Project
5. Future debt financing; **NOW THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The acquisition is hereby authorized to acquire a 12-acre parcel located at the corner of Richland Hills and Ingram Rd. in the amount of \$2,815,000.00 payable to SAWS for the development of multipurpose athletic fields and appropriating funds in the amount of \$1,500,000.00 and authorizing three annual payments in the amount of \$438,333.34 each in March 2016, March 2017, and March 2018, contingent upon approval of budgets in subsequent fiscal years. The City Manager and her designee, severally, are authorized to take all additional actions reasonably necessary or convenient to effectuate the transaction, including executing and delivering all instruments and agreements conducive to effectuating the transaction. A copy of the Transfer of Use Agreement is attached hereto substantially in the form shown in **Attachment I**.

SECTION 2. The budget in SAP Fund 40099000, Other Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 40-00452, TXDOT Disputes, shall be revised by decreasing SAP WBS Element 40-00452-03-14 entitled ROW Acquisition, SAP GL account 5209010, by the amount of \$1,499,139.46.

SECTION 3. The budget in SAP Fund 40099000, Other Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 40-00452, TXDOT Disputes, shall be revised by decreasing the SAP WBS Elements as follows:

SECTION 8. A Payment not to exceed \$2,815,000.00 in SAP Fund 45099000, General Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 40-00380, Northwest Area Recreational Facility, is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to SAWS for the acquisition of 12 parcels of privately owned real property located at the corner of Richland Hills and Ingram Rd for the development of multipurpose athletic fields in Council District 6 in Bexar County, Texas. Payment is limited to the amounts budgeted in the Operating and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with approved operating and/or capital budgets for current and future fiscal years



The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance

SECTION 10. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.



TRANSFER OF USE AGREEMENT

An Agreement is made this day between the City of San Antonio, hereinafter referred to as "CITY" in cooperation with the San Antonio Water System, hereinafter referred to as "SAWS", acting by and through duly authorized representatives, as follows:

WHEREAS, SAWS is the beneficial owner of a certain approximately 12.31 acre tract of real property which is more particularly described and depicted in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, herein referred to as the "SAWS Property";

WHEREAS, the SAWS Board of Trustees declared the SAWS Property surplus to the needs of SAWS pursuant to Resolution No. 12-304, approved on June 5, 2012;

WHEREAS, SAWS is a municipally owned utility of CITY;

WHEREAS, CITY desires to acquire use and control of the SAWS Property;

WHEREAS, CITY has agreed to provide compensation to SAWS for the transfer of use and control of the PROPERTY;

WHEREAS, this transfer has been approved by the SAWS Board of Trustees pursuant to Resolution No.15-091 approved on April 7, 2015; and

WHEREAS, this transfer has been approved by the City Council of the City of San Antonio pursuant to Ordinance No. _____ approved on _____;

NOW THEREFORE, THE PARTIES AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING TRANSFER OF USE:

SECTION I. SAWS hereby transfers use and control of the SAWS Property to CITY.

SECTION II. As consideration for this transfer, the City shall pay to SAWS the sum of \$2,815,000.00, payable as follows:

- a. Contemporaneously with the date of execution of this Transfer and Use Agreement, CITY shall pay SAWS the sum of \$1,500,000.00; and
- b. City shall thereafter make the following payments to SAWS: (i) a payment of \$438,333.34 due on or before March 1, 2016, (ii) a payment of \$438,333.33 due on or before March 1, 2017 and (iii) a payment of \$438,333.33 due on or before March 1, 2018. The City shall have the right to prepay any of the foregoing payments at any time.
- c. All obligations of the City of San Antonio under this instrument, save and except the obligation set forth in Section IIa hereinabove which has been appropriated by the San Antonio City Council pursuant to Ordinance No. _____ approved on _____, are funded subject to the availability and appropriation of funds by the San Antonio City Council.

SECTION III. Neither CITY nor SAWS by execution of this Transfer of Use Agreement waive or relinquish any right which they may have under the law or constitution, state or federal.

SECTION IV. **Condition of SAWS Property.**

(a) **Disclaimer.** SAWS hereby specifically disclaims any warranty, guaranty, or representation, oral or written; past, present or future, of, as to, or concerning (i) the nature and condition of the SAWS Property, including, but not by way of limitation, the water, soil, geology and the suitability thereof, and of the SAWS Property, for any and all activities and uses which CITY may elect to conduct thereon, income to be derived therefrom or expenses to be incurred with respect thereto, or any obligations or any other matter or thing relating to or affecting the same; (ii) the manner of construction and condition and state of repair or lack of repair of any improvements located thereon; (iii) the nature and extent of any easement, right-of-way, lease, possession, lien, encumbrance, license, reservation, condition or otherwise; and (iv) the compliance of the SAWS Property or the operation of the SAWS Property with any laws, rules, ordinances, or regulations of any government or other body. SAWS HAS NOT MADE, AND DOES NOT MAKE, ANY REPRESENTATIONS, WARRANTIES OR COVENANTS OF ANY KIND OR CHARACTER WHATSOEVER, WHETHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, WITH RESPECT TO THE QUALITY OR CONDITION OF THE SAWS PROPERTY, THE SUITABILITY OF THE SAWS PROPERTY FOR ANY AND ALL ACTIVITIES AND USES WHICH CITY MAY CONDUCT THEREON, COMPLIANCE BY THE SAWS PROPERTY WITH ANY LAWS, RULES, ORDINANCES OR REGULATIONS OF ANY APPLICABLE GOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITY OR HABITABILITY, MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, AND SPECIFICALLY, SAWS DOES NOT MAKE ANY REPRESENTATIONS REGARDING HAZARDOUS WASTE, AS DEFINED BY THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS AND ANY REGULATIONS ADOPTED PURSUANT THERETO OR THE U. S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY REGULATIONS AT 40 C.F.R., PART 261, OR THE DISPOSAL OF ANY HAZARDOUS WASTE OR ANY OTHER HAZARDOUS OR TOXIC SUBSTANCES IN OR ON THE PROPERTY. By accepting transfer of the use, benefit and control of the SAWS Property, CITY acknowledges that it has inspected the SAWS Property to its satisfaction. CITY agrees to accept transfer of the use, benefit and control of the SAWS Property with the SAWS Property being in its present AS IS condition WITH ALL FAULTS.

(b) **Property Condition.** CITY ACKNOWLEDGES AND AGREES THAT CITY IS EXPERIENCED IN THE OWNERSHIP, DEVELOPMENT AND/OR OPERATION OF PROPERTIES SIMILAR TO THE SAWS PROPERTY AND THAT CITY HAS INSPECTED THE SAWS PROPERTY TO ITS SATISFACTION AND IS QUALIFIED TO MAKE SUCH INSPECTION. 

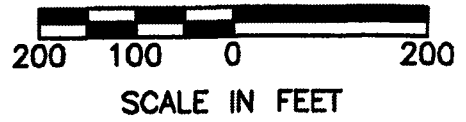

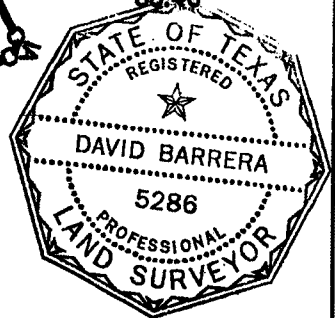
