AN ORDINANCE

RATIFYING A PURCHASE WITH APPLIED CONCEPTS, INC. FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT STALKER RADAR PACKAGES FOR PATROL VEHICLES AND MOTORCYCLES FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$61,775.40, FUNDED FROM THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OPERATING AND MAINTENANCE FUND.

WHEREAS, two offers were submitted by Applied Concepts, Inc. to provide the City of San Antonio Police Department with 18 Stalker radar packages for a total cost of \$61,775.40, using the Houston-Galveston Area Council contract #EF04-15; and

WHEREAS, the radar packages have already been received by the SAPD Traffic Division, though no purchase order was issued; and

WHEREAS, this purchase meets the requirements under the terms of the Houston/Galveston Area Council of Governments Cooperative Purchasing Agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio on October 10, 1996 through Resolution No. 96-41-48; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The purchases of Stalker radar packages, as described in the two offers from Applied Concepts, Inc. for a total cost of \$61,775.40, are hereby ratified.

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount up to \$61,775.40 for this ordinance is available in Fund 11001000, Cost Center 1704020001 and General Ledger 5304050, as part of the 2016 Carry Forward. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to Applied Concepts, Inc. and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
