

AN ORDINANCE 2015-08-06-0641

RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS FOR AN INCREASE OF UP TO \$10,750,000.00 TO A PREVIOUSLY APPROVED AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM GRANT OF UP TO \$8,000,000.00 FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION FOR THE RESIDENTIAL ACOUSTICAL TREATMENT PROGRAM AT SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

WHEREAS, the City regularly coordinates with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for continued Airport Improvement Program (AIP) funding for eligible projects at San Antonio International Airport; and

WHEREAS, in December 2014 City Council authorized Ordinance 2014-12-11-1019 which authorized the annual submission of a grant application and acceptance of funds for an FAA AIP grant in the amount not to exceed \$8,000,000.00 to fund the continuation of the Residential Acoustical Treatment Program (RATP); and

WHEREAS, in June 2015 the FAA notified the Aviation Department that additional AIP grant funds might be available, increasing the grant amount to \$18,750,000.00, but would require submission of a grant application by July 2, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Aviation Department submitted a grant application to the FAA for the additional AIP grant amount; and

WHEREAS, the FAA portion of the RATP grant(s) would be \$15,000,000.00 with the City providing \$3,750,000.00 in matching funds, an increase of \$2,150,000.00 from 2010 Airport Passenger Facility Charge Bonds and 2010 Passenger Facility Charge Tax Anticipated Notes; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to ratify the submission of a grant application and authorize the acceptance of grant funds for an increase of up to \$10,750,000.00 to a previously approved FAA AIP grant of up to \$8,000,000.00 for a revised grant amount of up to \$18,750,000.00 for the Residential Acoustical Treatment Program; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The submission of the FAA AIP grant application in the amount not to exceed \$18,750,000.00 is hereby ratified and the City Manager or her designee, or the Director of the San Antonio Aviation Department is hereby authorized to accept grant funds in an amount up to \$18,750,000.00 from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for the continuation of the Residential Acoustical Treatment Program.

SECTION 2. Upon approval of this ordinance, a new fund and internal order number will be created. Upon creation, the sum of \$18,750,000.00 from the FAA will be appropriated in said fund. A final budget will be provided upon acceptance of funds. This grant requires a match of \$3,750,000.00 that will be provided from various Aviation Funds.


SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.


